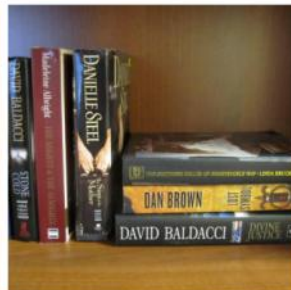

March 24– Have good laugh at America's Clown Prince Red Skelton at 2:00 in the Theatre Room.

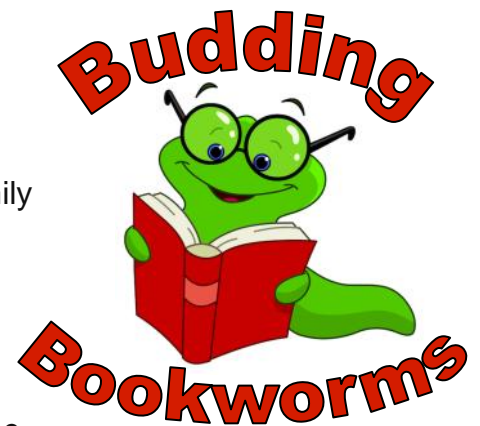
March 28– Come to our Town Hall. Let us know how we're doing and how we can improve to be even better!
